






During final year of HS, frequency of interaction with diverse students

















Likelihood while at Cornell... Get a job to help pay for college expenses




Likelihood while at Cornell... Participate in community service not as part of a course


Likelihood while at Cornell... Study abroad








Likelihood while at Cornell... Join a fraternity or sorority






